OWNER'S COVENANT

- A. Any grading, special ditching, alteration of slopes, or any other disturbance of any portion of highway right-of-way, shall be restored by and at the expense of the applicant, to the condition existing prior to such disturbance and to satisfaction of the Town of Byron.
- B. The entire cost of the driveway construction or installation shall be the obligation of the applicant.
- C. Applicant shall keep driveway culvert free of obstructions to provide proper drainage along highway.
- D. Maintenance and upkeep of driveway on and over town road right-of-way shall be responsibility of the applicant.
- E. **If driveway is to be paved with concrete, a 4 foot section from asphalt roadway to the concrete driveway must not be paved with concrete; it can have asphalt or gravel placed in this 4 foot section. If driveway is paved with asphalt, it can be paved with asphalt to match the road surface.**
- F. The applicant, his successors, or assigns, agree to hold harmless the Town of Byron and it's duly appointed agents and employees against any action for personal injury or property damage sustained by reason of the issuance or exercise of this permit.
